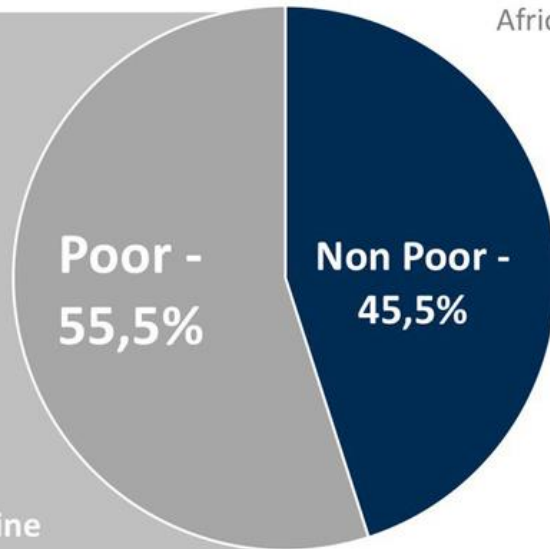




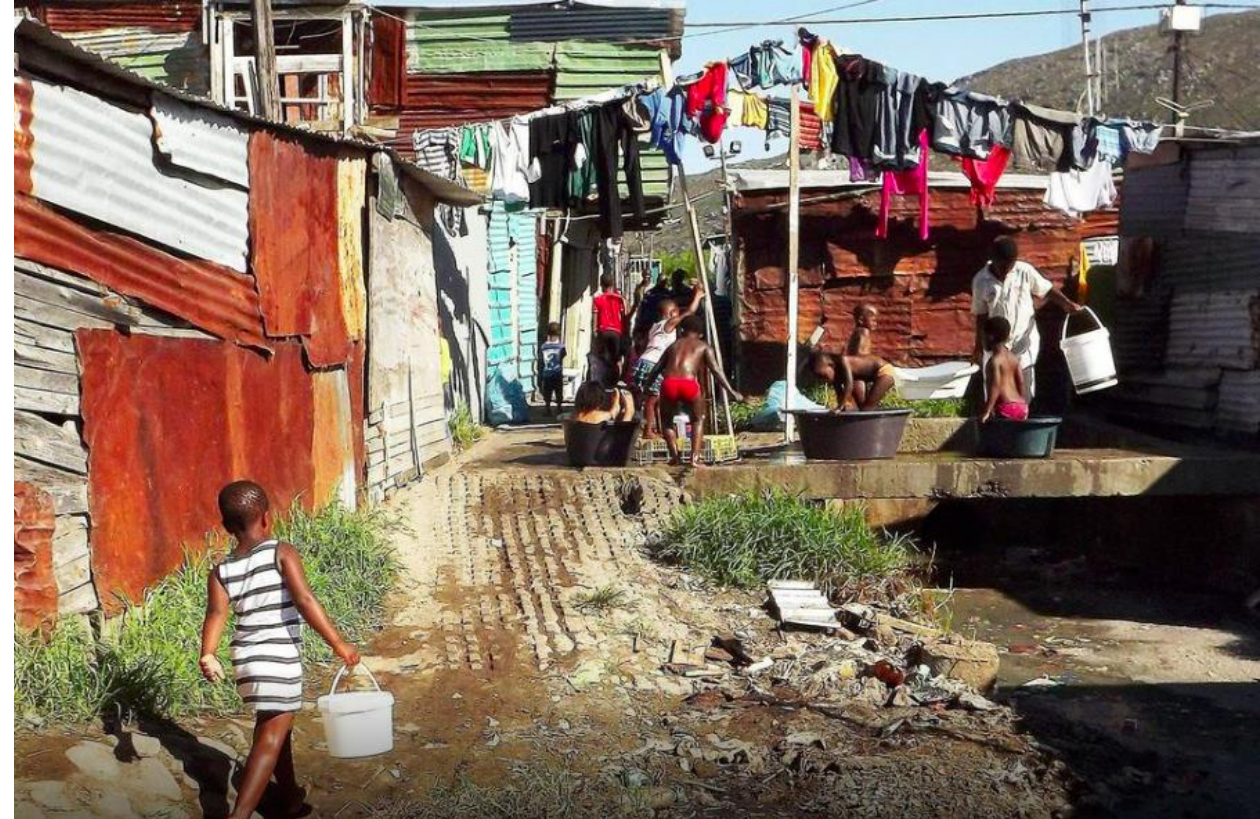

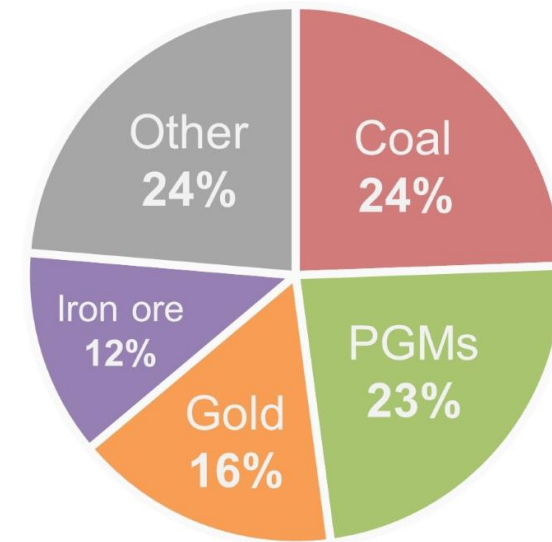

MAIN OBJECTIVE

Identify, and Incubate 10 Youth Owners Mining Companies over a period of 24 months, every year from 2019 and assist them to establish youth owned mines in Mpumalanga Province.

Assist those youth owned mines to access **Markets, Funding** and required skills to runs a **sustainable mining enterprises**.

PROJECT FUNDING

The project has an initial grant funding of

R20 million

from the Mpumalanga Provincial
Government

THE ROLE OF THE DMR

- Transparency in issuing mining rights and local youth ownership in the province.
- Transparency on information provided by mining companies on youth ownership participation.
- Facilitate and support collaboration between the youth directorate and mining companies.
- Ensure compliance with mining regulations especially BBBEE.
- Support the fast-tracking of the programme through access to information.

THE ROLE OF THE ESKOM

- Secured local coal market for the Future Miners.
- Annual set-aside of tonnage to be procured from companies in the Future Miner Incubation Programme.
- Recognise mining companies that partner with Future Miners incubations Programme.

THE ROLE OF THE PRIVATE SECTOR

- Support the programme by releasing non-core mineral rights for exploitation by **Future Miners**.
- Provide geological information to companies in the programme.
- Contribute funding to match and surpass government funding on the programme.
- Link existing youth development projects in their organisation with the **Future Miners Incubation Programme**.
